- The landlord for the tenancy must acknowledge they have let the property on the basis of the Tenancy Costs Cover (by completing and signing the Landlord's Acknowledgement on the landlord's letter)
- I must pay the landlord a bond of four weeks' rent, which the landlord must lodge with Tenancy Services at the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment
- A copy of the tenancy agreement and the receipt for the bond must be supplied to the Ministry of Social Development as soon as possible. The landlord's letter will ask your landlord to do this, but you should check with your landlord to ensure this is done
- My landlord will only be able to claim tenancy-related costs if:
 - the tenancy ends within 24 months from the tenancy start date
 - I owe the landlord tenancy-related costs, for example rent arrears or damages, in excess of the bond
