
NZQA results are now available. Now is the time to add the results for taiohi who are currently enrolled or have exited within the last three months and have completed an NCEA qualification.

To do this, in ART go to the young person's **Details > Education tab**.

Enter the Qualification details:

- Choose a Qualification level
- 2. Enter the Activity Provider name
- Enter the Final Assessment date (the date of the last internal or external assessment)
- Attach the Qualification Certificate
- Click on the 'Update Client' button.

updating and recording oranga tamariki info in art

we're no longer automatically receiving oranga tamariki information about taiohi

Some recent changes to MSD's IT systems means we're no longer receiving information from Oranga Tamariki. We're expecting to restart the automated updates for NEET MOE referrals later in 2025.

In the meantime, if a young person has been involved with Oranga Tamariki **in the past two years** you can ask YSSU to update Oranga Tamariki information in ART.

You can use **Request Client details update task** in ART to **Update OT details**.



What to do if a young person says they've been involved with Oranga Tamariki recently:

- 1. If they know the details: you can send a task through to YSSU to update the information in ART
 - you can request them from Oranga Tamariki by contacting them on 0800 55 89 89 or by email at transitionsupport@ot.govt.nz





tenancy law changes

changes have been introduced to people with a tenancy agreement

From 30 January 2025, landlords can end periodic tenancies without needing a specific reason by giving tenants a 90-day notice.

Landlords can end a periodic tenancy with 42 days' notice if:

- 1. The landlord or their family plans to live in the property as their main home within 90 days of the tenancy ending and stay for at least 90 days.
- 2. The property has been sold with an agreement requiring it to be empty.
- 3. The property is needed for the landlord's employees or contractors, as stated in the tenancy agreement.

Note: When a young person gets a 90-day notice they can still apply for emergency housing. We will look into the reason for the notice to determine if they have caused or contributed to their immediate housing need.

You can continue to request housing products to support young people in these situations.
