find a range of digital programmes in one place




labour day changes to payments

changes need to be reported early, and taiohi paid on tuesdays will be paid early

The Labour Day public holiday is coming up on Monday 27 October, this day changes when affecting payments need to be reported by and some payment dates will be earlier.

Taiohi will need to report any changes in MyMSD that will affect their payments (for example, wages or bank account details) the week of 27/10, so they are done by today 10pm (Thursday 23 October) usually this is on Fridays.

Taiohi who normally get paid on a Tuesday will be paid on Saturday 25 October. Make sure they understand that this is not a 'bonus payment'.







drop-in recap – programme fund

programme fund is available to help taiohi pay for things that help them improve their wellbeing, engage in education, or prepare for employment

Who can get it

The programme fund is available to young people fully enrolled in the NEET service or receiving YP or YPP.

What can they get

They can get up to \$500 (excl GST) per year to pay for things that help them to achieve the wellbeing, education, or employment goals they've made in their Youth Service plan.

It does not cover:

- things covered by hardship
- everyday costs
- Isv expenses
- overseas travel (including passports)
- costs funded by other agencies

what's changing for board payments in november

we're preparing to change the way we treat board payments from 2 march 2026

From 3 November

MyMSD boarder/renter declaration forms will prefill for people whose boarder information has been processed. This will make it easier for taiohi and other MSD clients to update their boarder information.

From 11 November

A second email will be sent to taiohi and MSD clients who may be affected by this change, and who have not declared boarder/renter information. This is to give them the opportunity to provide us with the correct information before the change takes place.
