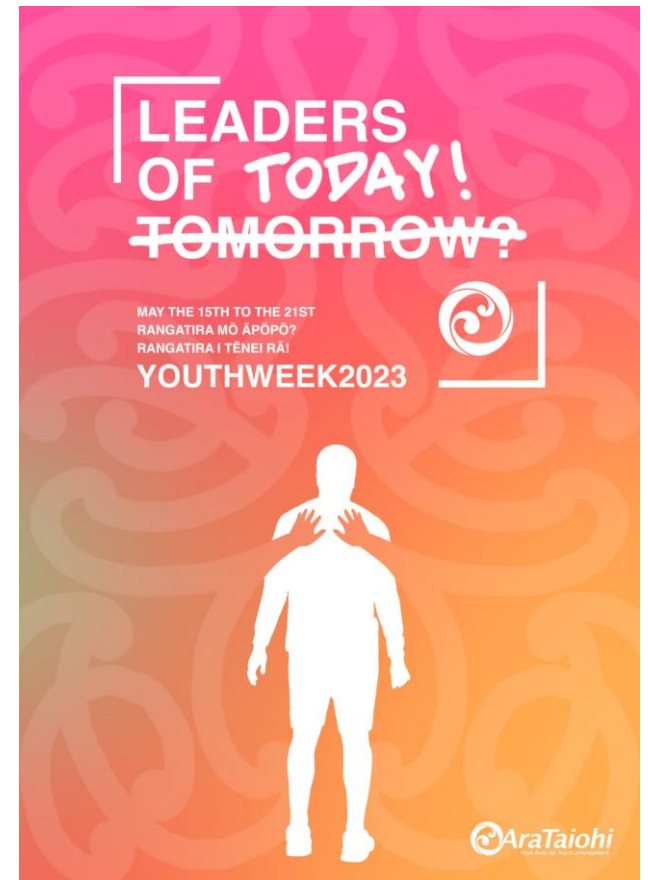
Check out the youth-focussed events happening in your region!

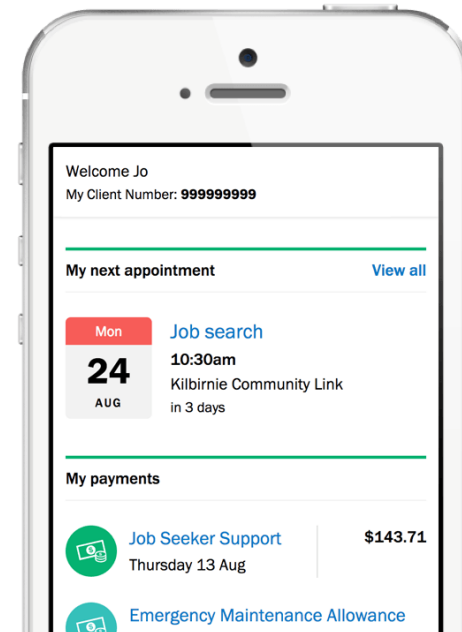
system upgrade impacting MyMSD

On **Sunday 14 May**, we're upgrading our systems, which will impact MyMSD.

From 6am to 4pm, there may be times where clients can't log in. When they can log in, they'll be able to declare wages and check payments, but won't be able to apply online, see their payment card balance, or update their details.

From 6am to 12pm, job listings will not be available in MyMSD and the link to the jobs website will return a '404 – page not found'.

From 12pm to 7am Monday 15 May, job listings will not be available in MyMSD, but the link to the jobs website will work.
