Budgeting and Parenting programmes update

Programmes can be delivered by an external Authorised Provider or by a Youth Service provider delivering an Approved Programme.

For most of you there won't be any change to what you're already doing.

- If you're delivering an Approved Programme you don't need to do anything
- If you have an external provider delivering an Approved Programme you just need to let us know the details of the provider
- If you're delivering your own programme or a programme that hasn't been approved yet it should be approved by the National Director Youth Services
- If you have an external provider delivering a programme that hasn't already been approved yet it should be approved by the National Director Youth Services

We've updated the guidelines for parenting and budgeting programmes


The changes allow for more flexibility in how you run your programmes.

Getting ahead of young people exiting Youth Service

You would already have your own exit plans for preparing for young people exiting Youth Service. Start updating their exit plan now for young people ageing out on 31 March.

New editable and printable exit plans

You can also use the exit plans on our provider website - links below. These plans capture the minimum standard of information and can be prefilled, printed and completed by the young person. The information recorded should prompt discussion between you and the young person. A copy of the exit plan should be given to the young person.
