Civil Defence payments: apply online - East Coast

MSD has created a form so that people from the East Coast region (Hawke's Bay and Tairāwhiti) who have client numbers can apply for Civil Defence payments online.

Those from the East Coast seeking payments for bedding, clothing or billeting/temporary accommodation can now apply on the <u>Work and Income website.</u>

Civil Defence processing standards

If your area is in a civil defence emergency, you can apply the Civil Defence processing standards.

The <u>Youth Service provider website</u> has been updated.

As at 21 February, the following areas can apply for the civil defence processing standards:

- East Coast
- Auckland
- Northland
- Central
- Waikato, but only the following four districts:
 - Waikato District Council
 - Thames/Coromandel District Council
 - Hauraki District Council
 - Matamata/Piako District Council.

Please use your discretion when using these processing standards. If you can meet with young people face-to-face, then please do so.
