reminder: guaranteed childcare assistance payment (GCAP)

As you know, some young parents receiving GCAP may have been impacted by the 1 April Annual General Adjustments (AGA).

Childcare Subsidy (CCS), which also helps with childcare costs, has changed. GCAP remains the same.

Please assess our young parents entitlement to GCAP and decide which support is better for them.

If a young parent wants to transfer to CCS, they will need to complete a Childcare Assistance – Change of Circumstances form.




reminder: alerts in ART

When a young person needs you to engage with them in a particular way or their behaviour poses a risk to your safety or they have been trespassed from your premises, you **must** add an alert in ART.

Alerts keep staff informed and safe.
