public transport discount for Community Service Card holders

Anyone with a Community Services Card can **apply now** for 50% off single-trip adult fares on public transport through the Community Connect concession. Young people need to apply through their local public transport provider. The discount can be used from **1 July**.

Please help us spread the word by encouraging young people to apply.

The Work and Income website has information and links to transport providers' websites.

Other Community Connect discounts

Other discounts will be made available as part of the Community Connect programme, but **may not be available straight away** in your region. These include:

- free fares for children aged 12 and under, and
- a 50% discount for anyone aged 13 to 24 and Total Mobility users.

Young people can check with their local transport provider for more information about when these will be available and how to apply.




how we're tracking - mark the date, 30 June!


new sector capability funding for Māori and Pacific organisations
