refresher: accommodation supplement

let's recap accommodation supplement (ASUP)

Accommodation Supplement is a weekly payment which helps young people with their rent, board or the cost of owning a home. If a young person changes their address, housing or accommodation costs, they need to tell us right away, as it could affect how much they're paid.

Supporting documents required:

- Accommodation Supplement application form (NEW applications)
- **ONLY** if costs are exceptionally high for the area, proof of what they pay for Rent or Board (**board costs DO NOT need to be itemised**)
- If the young person owns the home they live in:
 - proof of their home ownership costs, receipts for any repairs and maintenance costs and rates rebate.

NOTE: You'll need to complete a Redirection TASK if the young person is currently under Money Management



Want to know how much a young person might be able to receive on ASUP?

Give YSSU a call and ask them to complete a DREW assessment. YSSU can provide an estimate over the phone!



youth service neet evaluation now published

The Youth Service NEET evaluation has now been published and can be viewed here: [YS NEET evaluation report](#). The evaluation looked at the changes made in 2020 to increase support and focus on young people with higher needs.

The findings show that while Youth Service NEET continues to have mixed impacts, the service is now successfully reaching a more vulnerable group of young people with more complex needs. Investment per person has also increased to reflect the higher level of support being provided.
