family reconciliation counselling for taiohi

we all want what's best for taiohi - sometimes family reconciliation counselling might help

Family Reconciliation Counselling (FRC) is a service available for young people and their families where reconciliation is suitable and everyone is willing to participate.

FRC are available to all young people – NEET, YP, YPP and Young Partners – at any point in time. It can be used after a breakdown has occurred, or to stop one from happening

If you think FRC will help one of your taiohi contact YSSU.

Family Reconciliation Counselling can provide:

- a maximum of six one hour sessions per family
- face to face counselling with family members as appropriate in the opinion of the FRC Provider
- counselling within a timeframe that best supports the young person and their family.

During enrolment in the Youth Service, a young person may reconcile with their parents or guardians.


To give the young person with the best opportunity to reconcile the relationship, Youth Service may be able to use the previous family breakdown assessment.

Less than 90 days of the previous benefit being cancelled The existing FBA can be used If the young person's circumstances are the same as their previous application.

More than 90 days of the benefit being cancelled

YSSU will ask the young person to complete a new family breakdown assessment.

NZQA results are now available. Now is the time to add the results for taiohi who are currently enrolled and have exited within the last three months who have completed an NCEA Qualification.

To do this, in ART go to the young person's **Details > Education tab**.

Enter the Qualification details:

- 1. Choose a Qualification level
- 2. Enter the Activity Provider name
- 3. Enter the Final Assessment date (the date the last internal or external assessment)
- 4. Attach the Qualification Certificate
- 5. Click on 'Update Client' button.

waka kotahi: wait times for licence tests have increased

make sure taiohi are well prepared for their test


Wait times for driver licence tests have increased since Waka Kotahi changed their fees.

If taiohi don't pass, they may need to wait a while to get another slot. If taiohi fail their learners test twice on the same day, they will need to wait 10 working days before they can sit the test again. For more information check out the <u>Waka Kotahi</u> <u>website</u>.

If you haven't already, check out *Drive* and the *Drive Go app* to find a range of free resources that taiohi can use to prepare <u>Drive – everything</u> you need to prepare for your test.

Taiohi can't make their booking?

If taiohi get a test booking and can't use it, make sure they cancel on the <u>Waka Kotahi website</u> – even an hour's notice will mean someone else can use the slot.
