

new art task for paid employment

here's how to properly use the paid employment tasks

We've added a new activity for part-time employment. This will allow us to see how many young people are in part-time employment or paid employment.

To make an employment activity, you will need to make a 'Full time / part time employment' need.

When to use the 'Part-time Employment' activity


- for all young people on YP/YPP
- for young people in NEET who are working less than 30 hours per week

When to use the 'Paid Employment' activity

- For young people in NEET service who:
 - are working over 30 hours per week (including when they are working multiple jobs for a total of 30 hours of more)
 - are receiving in-work support by the youth coach.

Remember: taiohi on a payment can earn up to \$258.08 gross per week before their benefit is reduced

regular youth service update break


this is the last regular youth service update for the year
