


### system upgrades this weekend

On **Sunday 30 April from 6am to 4pm**, we're upgrading our systems which will impact MyMSD.

There may be times when clients can't log in. When they *can* log in, they'll be able to declare wages and check payments, but won't be able to apply online, see their payment card balance, or update their details.

From 7am to 10am, MyStudyLink and Apply Online will be undergoing planned maintenance. Clients will be able to view their information, but they won't be able to apply, update their details or make any changes.







### reminder to exit NEET clients who have aged out

When taiohi reach the age of 18 years and they are not continuing in education, training or work-based learning they are to be exited from the Youth Service unless:

- they were enrolled in an activity that ends in December. They can remain in service until 31 March the following year.
- if employed they can stay until they have completed 6 months employment.
- All NEET who turned 18 in the previous year must be exited by 31 March (unless they are still receiving six month in-work support)
