

It contains all the necessary information young people need to know about the NEET service.


This form is locked for editing, but you can add your logo and enter details in the editable fields.

We've created a new consent form to support providers who want to use photos and videos of young people in Youth Service.


This new consent form allows young people:

- · to grant consent autonomously
- to provide consent for children under 14 that they are legally responsible for
- (in the NEET service) to provide consent without needing their parents' or carers signatures

working with your young people in employment

Part one: tips for supporting taiohi who have work

Starting a new job can be a challenge.

We want to do everything we can to help taiohi succeed in a new job.

All NEET taiohi are eligible for in-work support for up to six months, and Youth Payment and Young Parent Payment clients might be able to get support through Mana in Mahi.

In-work support should be tailored to the needs of the young person.

We know from studies that intensive support in the first three months of placement to troubleshoot any issues can lead to better outcomes for the young person and their employer.







working with your young people in employment

part two: ways you can help taiohi

You can help with:

- ensuring taiohi get any support from us that they qualify for. For example, Accommodation Supplement, Working for Families, childcare costs, and disability costs
- giving advice on talking to their employer about things like working arrangements, training, and mentoring
- help with soft skills like time management, conflict resolution, leadership, and teamwork
- connecting taiohi to other services like Inland Revenue, budgeting, banking, and relationship services.







access to mymsd this sunday

let taiohi know access to mymsd will be limited this sunday

We're updating our systems on **Sunday 3 December from 6am to 7pm**

This will impact MyMSD.

There may be times when young people can't log in.

When they can log in, they'll be able to declare wages and check payments, but won't be able to see their payment card balance or update their details.
